

## WP1 – Project Management & Quality Assurance


## WP2 – Preparatory Phase & Peer Learning

WP2 sets the stage for **strong international collaboration**. EU partners (Greece and Germany) are paired with WB partners (Albania and Kosovo) through **Peer Learning Schemes**, exchanging knowledge and best practices. **Study visits** in Athens and Brussels showcase effective project management, R&D, dissemination, and networking methods. **Operational protocols and functional requirements** for international offices are developed to ensure efficiency, sustainability, and smooth day-to-day management.
